

QUAIL HILL DAY CAMP

Quail Hill Day Camp is a well structured activity based program. Participants are encouraged to try their hand at a wide variety of activities each day. Some of the activity areas include BB and Archery ranges, an Olympic sized swimming pool, crafts, sports and games, boating, fishing and outdoor skills. Children are placed in small manageable groups of similar ages and are under direct adult supervision. Boys and girls ages 6 to 10 are welcome to come to Day Camp even if they are not currently enrolled in the program.

DAY CAMP FEES - Day camp fees are \$215 per week. All camp fees should be paid in full 2 weeks prior to the start of the camp session. Financial assistance and discounts available.

BUS TRANSPORTATION - Bus transportation is available for our Day Camp sessions at \$65.00 per week. Please remember to fill out your bus stop choice on your day camp application. There will be a required minimum of 10 riders for us to run the bus for that week at camp.

QUAIL HILL RESIDENT CAMP

The Quail Hill Resident Camp program is divided into two types. There are two half-week sessions and one full-week session. All sessions utilize the day camp program during the day and have additional program in the evenings. Participants will be organized into dens and will camp in two-man tents outfitted with wooden walkways between bunks. Children are under direct adult supervision. Boys ages 6 to 10 are welcome to come to Resident Camp even if they are not currently enrolled in the program.

- Session #2 - July 26 - July 31, 2009 (Full Week)
- Session #3 - Aug 4 - Aug 7, 2009 (1/2 Week)

Check in is from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on opening day.

Your son should eat dinner before his arrival at camp. All Meals during Resident camps are provided.



RESIDENT CAMP FEES - Resident camp fees are \$265 for our full week session and \$165 for our half week sessions. All camp fees should be paid in full 2 weeks prior to the start of the camp session. Financial assistance and discounts available.
